

Webinar Series: Fundamentals of equine practice

Shoulder and elbow injuries

Monday 23rd November

Approaching uncommon but important injuries of the equine proximal forelimb.

This webinar will cover diagnostic and therapeutic approaches for proximal forelimb injuries involving the shoulder and elbow. Focus will be placed on collateral ligament injuries of the elbow and bicipital tendinopathy, including imaging strategies, diagnostic analgesia, and treatment options such as conservative management, bursoscopy, or tenectomy. Prognostic considerations for these less common but impactful injuries will also be explored.

Why do this course?

This course is designed for practitioners wishing to strengthen their knowledge of less frequently encountered but clinically significant shoulder and elbow pathologies. Delegates will learn to recognise injury patterns, apply appropriate imaging and diagnostic tools, and manage these conditions with confidence.

Key areas:

- Elbow collateral ligament injuries and avulsions
- Bicipital tendonitis: acute and chronic presentations
- Management options and prognostic factors
