

Webinar Series: Fundamentals of equine practice

Stifle injuries

Monday 9th November

Understanding and managing soft tissue injuries of the equine stifle.

This webinar will provide a detailed look at the diagnostic and therapeutic approaches for common stifle soft tissue injuries in horses. Topics will include meniscal tears, cruciate ligament injuries, and patellar ligament desmitis, supported by imaging and arthroscopic findings. Prognostic considerations, treatment strategies, and case outcomes will be discussed in depth.

Why do this course?

This course is aimed at equine practitioners with an interest in orthopaedics or sports medicine. Delegates will learn how to accurately evaluate stifle lameness, apply advanced diagnostic techniques, and make evidence-based treatment decisions. The session will highlight prognostic differences depending on the structure affected, equipping vets with practical knowledge to apply in daily practice.

Key areas:

- Diagnostic work-up of stifle injuries
- Meniscal pathology: imaging and prognosis
- Cruciate and patellar ligament desmitis: recognition and management
