Diagnostic analgesia of the hindlimb (excluding the foot) and its interpretation

Do you want to increase your confidence in performing and interpreting nerve and joint blocks in the hind limbs of equine patients??

This course is aimed at new and recent graduates and veterinarians wanting to improve their confidence in regard to diagnostic analgesia in the hind limb. After a refresher in anatomical knowledge in regard to loco-regional anaesthesia, principles of nerve and joint blocking will be explored with specific emphasis its interpretation in the equine hind limb.

Why do this course?

It is designed to give the equine practitioners who deal with lameness a better understanding of the use of diagnostics anaesthesia and its interpretation.

The key areas that will be covered by the lecture are the common anaesthetic agent used in lameness diagnosis, common landmarks and techniques used for nerve and joint blocks in the hind limb and how to best interpret the results.

The webinar will run on from **12.00pm to 1.00pm** London time including a 30 minute registration and familiarisation period prior to the commencement of the lecture.
