In this course, the RVC nephrology and urology team will take complex consult calls that are received from practitioners relating to the upper and lower urinary tract and focus on how to approach and manage these difficult situations. The clinical scenarios will be based on situations that are faced in every day practice but will include information on when referral for advanced diagnostics and therapeutics might be appropriate but also considering how these situations can be managed often in primary care.

Why do this course?

This course is aimed at veterinary surgeons who would like to optimise their problem solving approach to complex urinary cases. The session will be a diverse array of clinical problems relating to the upper and lower urinary tract giving practical guidance on how to undertake focused diagnostic investigations for the best patient and client outcomes.
